1 Cleaning and Sanitizing of Vehicles

Enhanced cleaning based on CDC recommendations and industry practices.

Vehicles and transit facilities are cleaned every day, and frequently touched surfaces are disinfected throughout the day.

2 Requiring Face Mask

The State of California and San Benito County have made it mandatory to wear a face covering while riding transit.

Passengers must wear a proper face covering or will not be permitted to ride unless exempt.

3 Maintaining a Healthy Workforce

All employees are provided protective equipment and supplies to safely do their jobs.

As essential workers, employees receive priority COVID-19 testing and are required to stay home if sick.

4 Safely Distance

Health officials recommend maintaining a safe distance of 6 feet from others.

Please spread out while waiting for and riding transit, except when with people from your own household.

5 Service Adjustments

As shelter-in-place restrictions ease, we continue to adjust service and return to full operations, including resuming fare collection.

We are operating limited services and will continue to make adjustments through 2020.
